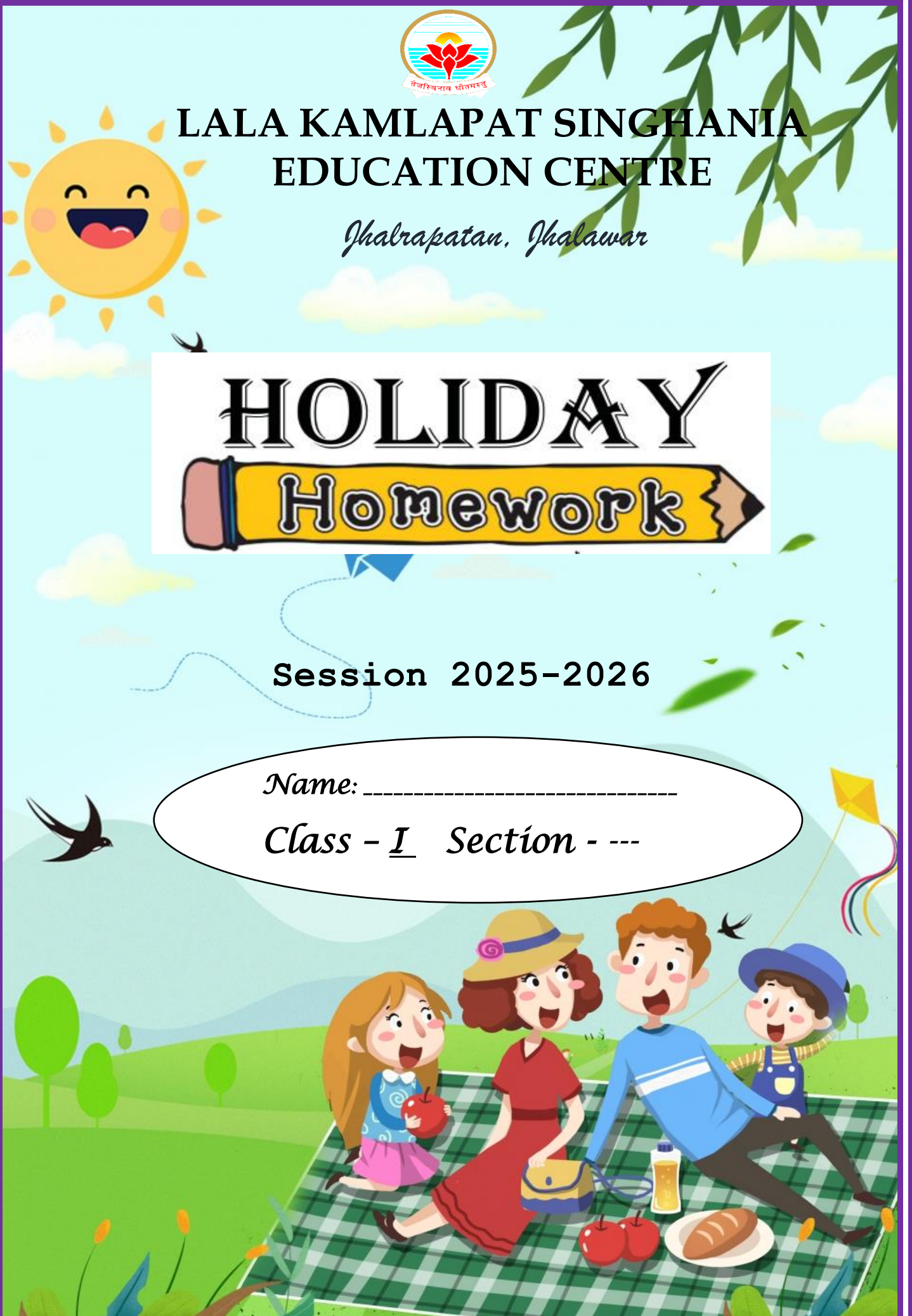

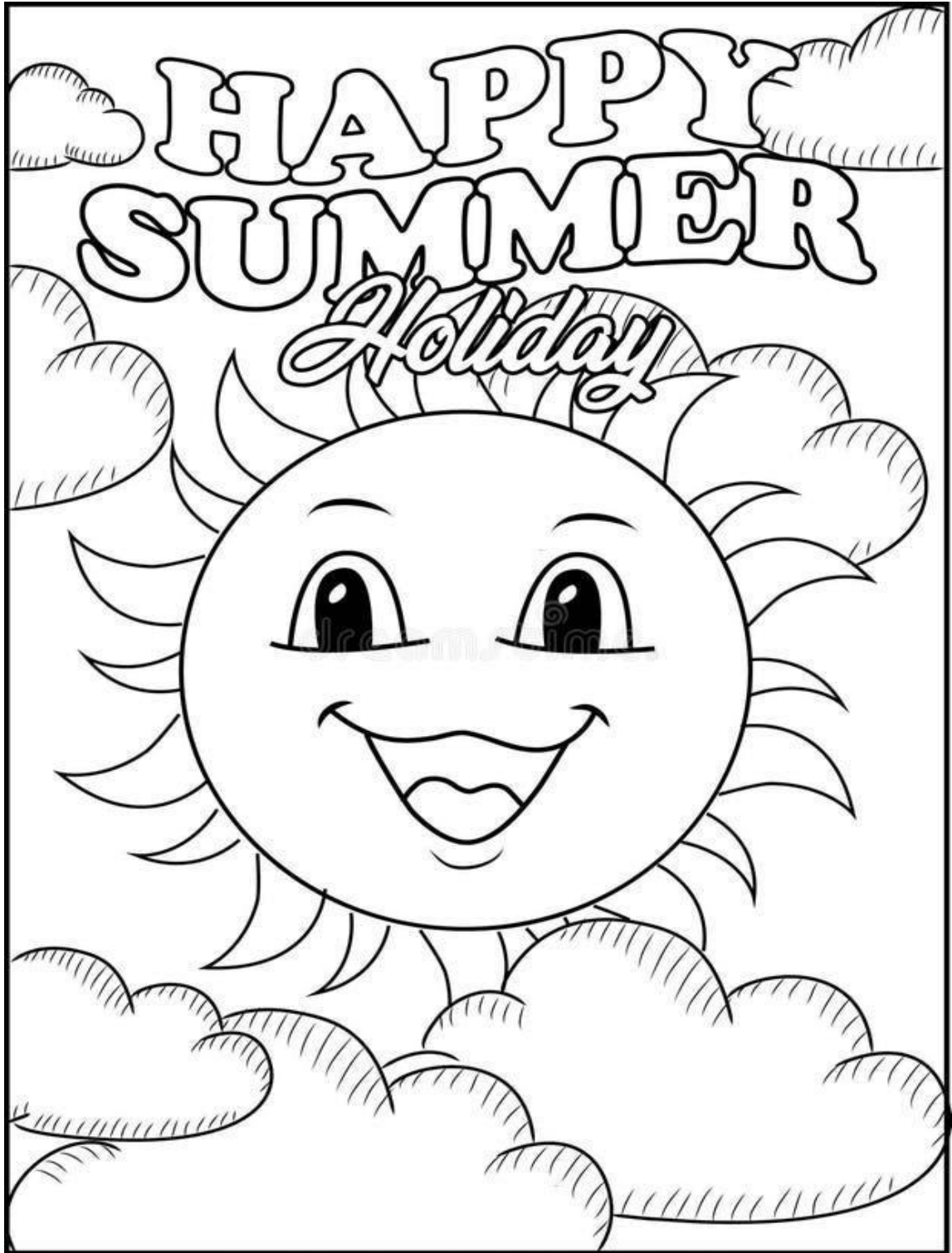

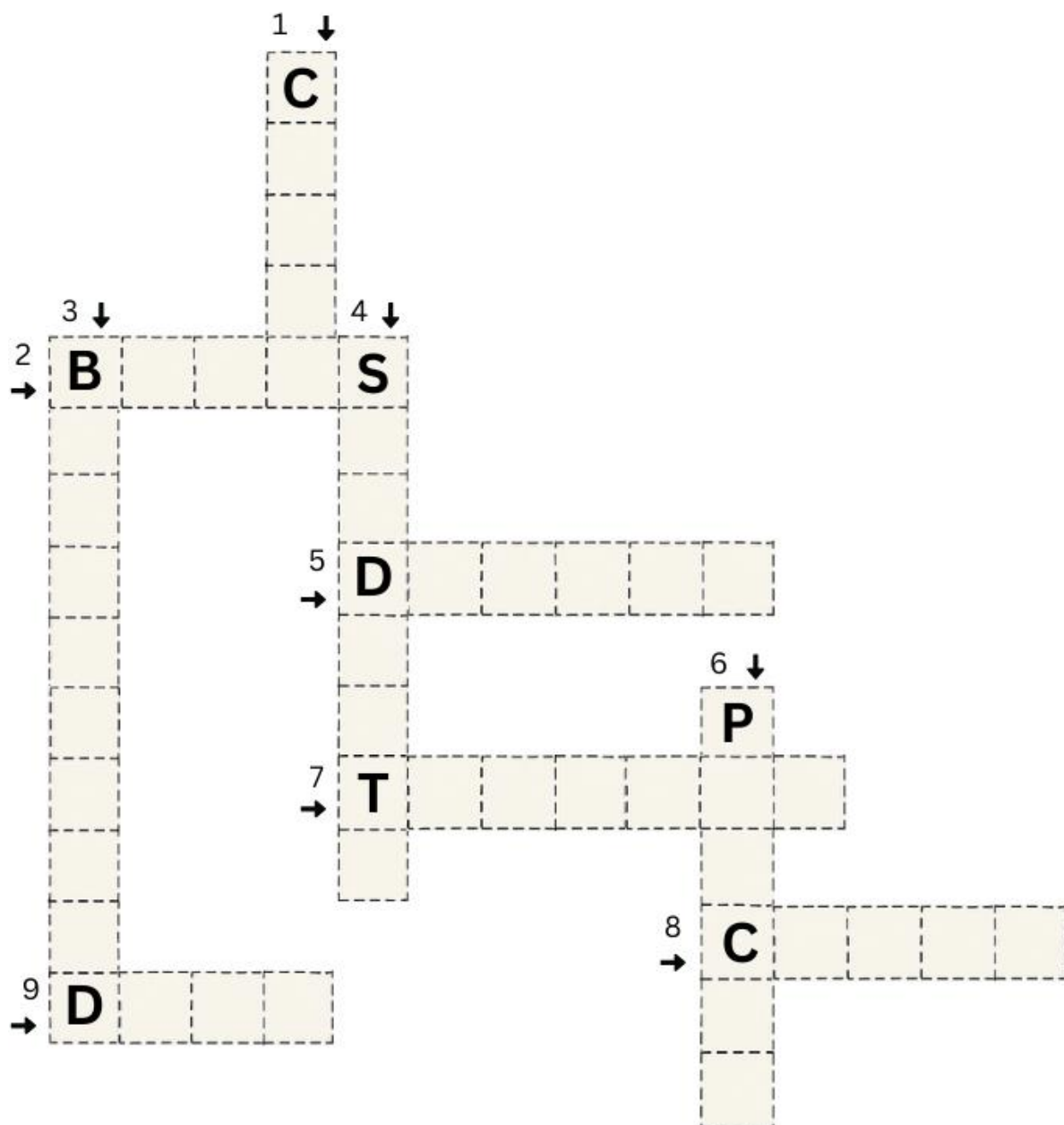


General Instructions:
